STARBASE INDIANA-SOUTH BEND HAS THE FOLLOWING SESSIONS OPEN FOR HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATES AND COLLEGE MENTORS TO APPLY:

STARBASE INDIANA SOUTH BEND TRADITIONAL CAMPS will be a STARBASE STEAM experience. Get ready to explore flight, 3D design, and engineering problem solving with STEAM centered projects during your camp week this summer. Special activities include collaboration with Notre Dame's DNA Learning Center and TurboMachinery Laboratory. This is an opportunity that your camper won't want to miss! Those eligible for Traditional Camp week include campers entering 5th – entering 8th grade.

STARBASE ADVANCED ENGINEERING CAMP is four-day educational STEM experience centered around the designing and building of machines and structures. Unlike our Traditional Camps, this is a less guided experience which allows participants to develop their own creative solutions to solve engineering challenges. Campers will explore opportunities to work as a team to achieve their goals. Campers eligible for Advanced Camp include campers entering 6th - entering 9th grade.

SO, WHAT IS A MENTOR?

A mentor is a source of wisdom, teaching and support. Our mentors will help guide and direct our campers in hands-on, mind-on STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math) learning. A mentor offers encouragement and cheerleading, but not "how to" advice. Mentoring is also an opportunity for personal and professional growth, increasing skills of leadership and team collaboration.

SO, WHAT IS STARBASE?

STARBASE Indiana is a premier educational program, sponsored by the Department of Defense. At STARBASE Indiana students participate in challenging "hands-on, minds-on" activities in Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math (STEM). Students interact with STEM professionals to explore careers and observe STEM applications in the real world. The program encourages students to set goals and achieve them. At summer camp, we incorporate the ARTS to create STEAM as we progress toward more hands-on, and interactive learning goals.

SO, WHAT DOES IT TAKE TO BE A STARBASE INDIANA SUMMER MENTOR?

- Mentors will be required to attend training on the first day of Camp at 8:15, and staff will provide information needed for tasks during summer camp.
- This is an excellent opportunity to give to our community efforts, as well as a great resume builder for future college or career applications.
- Mentors are preferred to be week-long assistants; however, openings are available for select days only.
- Mentors must provide their own transportation to and from the South Bend Armory.
- All applicants subject to background checks as required.
- Applicants selected based on eligibility criteria and interviews conducted by STARBASE Indiana staff.
